CSIRO Workshop - Introduction to the NDI Carrara 1 Hylogger Dataset Monday 4 April | 2:30pm – 5:00pm

This CSIRO run workshop will provide an introduction to using Hylogger hyperspectral mineralogy outputs for informing geological logging, alteration mapping, and sampling using the NDI Carrara 1 dataset(s) as a case study. It will include a brief introduction to hyperspectral mineralogy and The Spectral Geologist (TSG) software, but the focus will be on providing the tools for visualizing and investigating the Carrara 1 HyLogger data in TSG in the context of other imported geoscience datasets including geochemistry (Minalyze CS data), and also exporting the outputs for use in other software packages.

This workshop is recommended for anyone interested in working with Hylogger data, and in particular the NDI drill hole datasets. No previous hyperspectral mineralogy experience is required.
